

1. Everyone is a sinner. Nobody is perfect.

Romans 3:23 – For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Romans 3:10 – As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

2. Because of sin (breaking God's rules) we all deserve God's punishment for sin: to suffer eternal torment in hell (the second death). No amount of good works or living right will change the fact that we all deserve to go to hell.

Romans 6:23 – For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Revelation 21:8 – But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

3. Fortunately God doesn't want anyone to go to hell. So he sent Jesus Christ, God manifest in the flesh, to suffer our punishment for us. Jesus was tempted in every way like as we are, yet he lived a sinless life. He was crucified on the cross, was buried, and rose again. Jesus suffered in our place so that we could be made righteous through him.

2 Corinthians 5:21 – For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

1 Peter 2:24 – Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Romans 5:8 – But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

4. Salvation (being saved from punishment in hell) is a free gift from God that we receive the moment we believe that only Jesus can save us. We need to only trust in His finished work on the cross. This gift of salvation is eternal and everlasting life. This means that once we receive this gift from God, we can never lose it and he will never take it away.

Acts 16:30-31 – And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

John 3:16 – For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 6:47 – Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.

John 11:25-26 – Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die.

5. You must trust in Jesus alone for your salvation. There is nothing else you need to do, or can do, to get to heaven other than believe on Him. If you think that you need to live a good life or do good works to go to heaven, you are telling Jesus that he didn't do enough on the cross. While doing good things and living a good life is important, those works will never save you.

Ephesians 2:8-9 – For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

6. If there was anything a believer could do to make God send him to hell after receiving the gift of salvation (including murder or suicide) that would mean that God lied when he promised us eternal, everlasting life. But God cannot lie.

Titus 1:2 – In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

7. When you believe 100% on the Lord Jesus Christ for your salvation, you are born again into God's family and become His child. You will never go to hell but God will discipline you here on earth. A believer that lives a life full of sin will never go to hell, but God will punish him in this life on earth.

Galatians 3:26 – For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 12:6-7 – For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth. If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?

8. When you believe all this, you need to ask God for the free gift of salvation by calling on the name of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

Romans 10:9-10 – That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Here is a prayer you can say to tell God that you only trust in Jesus for your salvation:

"Dear Jesus, I know that I'm a sinner. I know that I deserve to go to hell, but I believe you died on the cross for me and rose again. Please save me right now and give me eternal life. I'm only trusting in you, Jesus. Amen."

NOW THAT I'M SAVED, WHAT SHOULD I DO?

While doing good works doesn't get us into heaven, once we are saved we should do good things and live a good life in order to please God and receive his blessing.




